Talk It Over

- 4. Read Ephesians 4:20-24. What does it mean to put off the 'old self' and to put on the "new self"? Is this the standard of conduct among the members of your local church? If not, why not?
- 5. Many polls taken today concerning the moral conduct of the church in Western society show very little difference in behavior between professed Christians and the rest of our society. What is your assessment of this information?
- 6. Ephesians 5:11commands followers of Jesus to 'expose' what Paul calls 'deeds of darkness'. What does that mean? What would it look like in our culture today? How does Paul's command to 'speak the truth in love' (4:15) apply?
